Pool Sign In

All members are **required** to sign in each time you use the pool. It is also **required** that every guest, both in and out of town, be signed in. Please sign in each member of your family by name as well as each guest. This information helps us maintain accurate records related to how many individuals use the pool each day. We use this information to help guide decisions related to pool operating hours. Please see the sample below:
