From the Course Superintendent

We have been extremely busy on the maintenance staff this last month. Between the project on 6 and 8 and regular maintenance of the golf course there is no shortage of tasks to complete.

Labor has really been a big issue for us this year. We started the year off in decent shape with a full staff. However, as the season progressed, we have lost employees for multiple reasons. We also have had associates get sick this year and be out for multiple days at a time. This has resulted in me adjusting the mowing schedule and prioritizing different tasks, so we try and complete everything that needs to happen to make sure we provide the best possible playing conditions. I appreciate your understanding and realize most of you are in the same predicament at your respective place of employment and businesses.

We have entered a dry period and you may have noticed LDS spots on some of the greens and fairways. What is an LDS spot? It is a localized dry spot, and it is caused by a waxy coating forming around the soil that repels water. The water will bead up and run off instead of penetrating into the ground. Once that waxy coating is on the soil it is exceedingly difficult to remove from the soil and that is how the dry spots develop. How do we solve the problem? We use wetting agents to break that waxy coating off the soil so water can penetrate the soil and distribute throughout the ground.

You may have also noticed that the greens may have been a little slower than usual. We are in the process of replacing the engine on the roller. I apologize and we will work to get it back online as quick as possible. We will be reseeding 5 and 8 again soon. Unfortunately, those last torrential rains caused all our seed to wash away. This is a great project and when it is complete it will really be great for the golf course.

Holiday Hours

Adult Swim

Umbrellas

We apologize for the frustration that inconsistent use of the umbrellas has caused. Unfortunately, the wind has not been our friend this year and six table umbrellas have been destroyed so far as a result of the wind. We will continue to do our best to communicate in advance when umbrellas will not be available; however, as much as we wish we could, we cannot control the weather and there may be a time that our plan has to change mid-day. Thank you for your cooperation during these times.

Member/Guest Sign In

All members and their guests are required to sign in at the guest book upon entry to the pool. If multiple members of your family are present, please include all member names, not just the name of an adult. Thank you for your help in maintaining accurate records.

Safety

Please remember that lifeguards are present to ensure safety and to enforce pool rules. Lifeguards made two rescues during the month of June. Parents are responsible for supervision of their children. Non-swimmers must have an adult in the pool with them. Lifeguards may, at any time, request that a swimmer demonstrate that they're able to support themselves in the pool. Plastic toys such as water guns and balls are not allowed in the pool. Pool toys must absorb water in order to avoid accidental injuries. The most shallow area of the pool near the stair entry is reserved for our youngest members and their parents. Adults wishing to socialize in the pool are asked to do so in the four foot area and beyond. Thank you for your cooperation as we work to ensure a safe environment for all of our members.

Snack Bar

Only food that is listed on the display board is available at the snack bar. Unfortunately, staffing does not allow for snack bar staff to order or deliver food from other areas of the club. Members are always welcome to order from other areas of the club if they choose. Food service is always available in the snack bar area. Snack bar staff may, if possible, bring food to members on the pool deck depending on availability. It is preferred that all food be consumed in the snack bar area in order to help maintain water quality and cleanliness of the pool deck area.

Pool Filtration

As the mechanical system at the pool continues to age, we ask for your help with caring for our pool filtration system by helping us ensure that we limit unnecessary items and bacteria that may interfere with the system's ability to function. Ways that you can do this include:

- Babies are asked to wear rubber pants over swim diapers
- No popcorn is allowed inside the pool fence area
- Food is not allowed directly around the pool perimeter. Members may enjoy food at tables and chairs, but are not allowed to have food next to or in the pool
- Rinse off in the locker room prior to entering the pool
