From the Course Superintendent

Can you believe that it is June already? It seems like time is moving so fast this year. The maintenance crew has been busy with lots of projects on the golf course this spring. We have been planting flowers, laying mulch down, trimming bushes, grinding reels, topdressing greens, doing irrigation repairs, applying fertilizer and growth regulators, and many other projects and tasks.

One thing that I would like to talk about is deep tine aeration of the greens. Come this August 22, Geneva will be deep tine aerating their greens for the first time ever. What is the benefit of deep tine aeration? Deep tine aeration encourages better water infiltration, root growth, and gas exchange. It also allows us to introduce sand into the soil profile which makes for better growing conditions which equals better playing conditions. Geneva has native push up greens that are hard and compacted so this will help to reduce the compaction on the greens as well. The machine will pull a core about 6-10 inches deep and then we will remove that core from the green and backfill with sand into the aeration holes. Recovery is usually about 10-12 days following this procedure. This will make the greens so much better here at Geneva.

From the Pool Manager

We are excited to open the pool & snack bar for the summer season. The pool officially opened on Saturday, May 28. Please take note of a few highlights /changes this season:

- **Pool rules have been updated** and are attached to this month's newsletter. Please take the time to read through them as well as discuss them with your children if they use the pool independently.
- **All guests (both in and out of town) must sign in and pay a \$5.00 guest fee.** Please remember that you are responsible for your guests and ensuring that they are signed in when you arrive. Adult children of members must also pay a guest fee when using the pool and must be accompanied by a member.
- Registration for swimming lessons begins on May 23rd. Six-week long sessions are available.
- Do you know someone who is interested in becoming a lifeguard? If there is enough interest, we will offer a lifeguard course this summer.
- The pool is available for rental. We ask that you schedule parties 2 weeks in advance to allow for scheduling of lifeguards.
- Pool Hours are as follows:
 - ⇒ Open Swim: Monday-Saturday 11:30-7:30 & Sunday 12-7
 - ⇒ **Adult Swim: NEW this year!** Monday-Friday 9-10:30am. This is a time for adults, aged 18 and over to exercise and enjoy the pool. No children are allowed during this time and the deep end will be closed as only one lifeguard will be assigned to this shift.

Pool Guidelines for Geneva Members & Guests

The following regulations have been set to help ensure a safe, healthy and pleasant experience for everyone. If at any time you need assistance, please ask any member of our staff. Please enjoy the facility and have a great summer!

Please Remember: Safety First!

- Adult Swim: Limited to adults age 18 & over who are engaged in pool exercise activities. No children are allowed during this time and the deep end will be closed.
- The pool is for the use and enjoyment of Club members. **All guests** must pay a \$5.00 fee and be signed in.
- Regulation swimming suits are required of all members and guests using the pool. Cut-off jeans, shorts, and sweatpants are prohibited in the pool. T-shirts may be worn on deck but are not allowed in the water. Those with medical or religious conflicts should contact the Pool Manager.
- Upon request of a lifeguard, a child may be asked to demonstrate the ability to swim in good form before being allowed to swim in the deep end. Non-swimmers are not allowed in the diving well.
- Children must be 8 years of age or older to use the pool facility without being accompanied by an adult. Parents are encouraged to use their discretion when making this decision due to the varying maturity levels of children. The pool manager will contact parents with concerns.
- Only one person is allowed on the diving board at a time. Swimming in the diving area is not permitted when the boards are in use.
- Toys, balls, noodles, or other pool related toys are permitted; however, may be removed at the discretion of the lifeguards or the pool manager due to inappropriate use or other safety concerns.

POOL GUIDELINES *cont.*

- Children who are not toilet-trained must wear protective garments.
- There will be a 15 minute adult swim at 3pm daily.
- Dangerous behavior such as rough play, running on deck, throwing each other, riding on shoulders or diving off legs, arms, hands or back is not permitted.
- Geneva prohibits the following items from the pool and pool area: gum, glass, cigarettes, and any other item deemed potentially dangerous.
- Food and beverages are welcome in the pool area. Please help us keep our facility clean by throwing away wrappers and containers. No food or beverages will be brought in from outside the club unless previously discussed with Club Management.
- Chairs are intended for use by adult members and are not to be used for towel and personal item storage.
- In order to ensure an atmosphere that is welcoming to all pool users, the pool radio channel will remain on the local channel chosen by pool staff. Members and their guests are welcome to listen to personal musical selections using earbuds or headphones in order to ensure a relaxing environment. Bluetooth speakers that project personal music are not permitted.
- All personal possessions must be placed in the locker room or stored on deck where the member can monitor them. The lifeguards will not be responsible for personal possessions of members or their guests.
- Please help us keep the locker room clean and orderly. Please report any problems to a staff member.

Please note: Lifeguards are on duty for the safety of Geneva members and guests. Parents are responsible for the supervision of their children.

Pool Parties

The swimming pool is available to members for private parties before or after normal operating hours. Reservations must be made with the pool manager a minimum of two weeks in advance to allow adequate time for staffing. Geneva staff lifeguards are required for pool parties.
